The Belleville Country club is seeking a hardworking and dependable candidate to fill the position of Head Greenskeeper. The greenskeeper is responsible for the upkeep and maintenance of the golf course grounds, equipment, and facilities. This position will require a minimum commitment of 40 hours per week during the golf season (approx. March-October), with hours varying during the off-season although up to 40 hours per week is still possible. The Head Greenskeeper is responsible for a variety of tasks and is expected to be able to efficiently manage these tasks, show initiation, and effectively communicate wants/needs/concerns regarding the position to the Board of Directors.

Key Duties & Responsibilities:

- Mowing of tees, greens, surrounds, fairways, rough and semi-rough using a range of equipment.
- Setting up golf course for daily play including placing tee markers, setting cups/pins, maintaining ball washers, raking sand bunkers, and marking hazards.
- Caring for equipment including but not limited to maintaining fuel and fluid levels on all equipment, inspecting equipment daily and reporting any safety and/or mechanical issues, and performing or scheduling routine preventative maintenance such as oil changes, blade sharpening, etc.
- Upkeep of maintenance shed facility and surrounding outside area.
- Applying fertilizers and other chemicals as directed to improve the health and quality of the overall course landscape.
- Operating irrigation systems and troubleshooting issues as they may arise. Regular general maintenance and repair of these systems is required.
- Identifying and placing controls for any and all pests and diseases.
- Maintaining rental carts including fueling, maintenance as needed, and overall cleanliness.
- Supervising of other seasonal groundskeeping employees.
- Other duties and projects as directed and in coordination with the Board of Directors.

Qualifications & Requirements:

- Valid drivers license.
 - General golf knowledge and/or work experience.
 - Proficiency in using manual and power tools safely.
 - Ability to follow oral and written communications and directions from the Board of Directors.
 - Physical strength to perform the duties and responsibilities of the job.
 - Ability to sit, stand, or walk for prolonged periods of time.
 - General mechanical knowledge.
